
#### " Art of Calligraphy: Training and Techniques" 26/12/2020 to 11/01/2021



#### A View of Certificate Distribution















Recommendations for Minimising the Risks associated with Floods in Kashmir:


#### Recommendations for Minimising the Risks associated with Floods in Kashmir:

- 1. By educating the common masses about the possible effects of floods and mitigation measures for the same.
- 2. Dredging of water bodies like Wullar lake, Hokersar, Narkara Numbal, Nowgam Jheel, Haigam Jheel, Khushalsar, Anchar Lake. Gilsar, to increase their flood retention capacities and rejuvenation of their existing inter-linkages subject to the technical feasibility and Environmental Impact Analysis (EIA).
- 3. Increasing the Carrying capacity of the Outfall Channel of River Jhelum from Sopore to Baramulla.
- 4. Development of more flood channels in order to increase the flood water retention capacity.
- 5. Proper maintenance of wetlands and putting ban on their encroachment.
- 6. Integration and proper coordination of different departments like Irrigation and Flood control, Disaster management, CAPD, Health Department etc.

- 7. Anti-erosion and training works on tributaries of River Jhelum.
- 8. Augmentation of Automation and up gradation of flood monitoring system of Jhelum Basin by installing Automatic water level recorders, Automatic discharge recorders and automatic weather stations, etc.

#### Conclusion:

As our Webinar was based on two sessions first one was from 11 am to 11:50 am and the next one was conducted from 12 pm to 12:50 pm in which good number of participants participated, interacted with speakers and got benefitted. During the programme the said invited speakers successfully enlightened the audience with their knowledge and experience related to disasters with special reference to flood disasters. 



#### Report

Government Degree College for Women, Anantnag Department of Political Science & History Theme of the webinar: "Gandhi Jayanti" 05 October 2020 The Department of Political Science and History celebrated "Gandhi Jayanti" on 05th October 2020. On this occasion a webinar was organised to deliberate upon different aspects of Gandhian life & philosophy. Faculty members of both the departments spoke on the occasion. The webinar began with a welcome address by the Head, Department of Political Science, Dr. Mohd Amin Malik. In his speech, Dr Malik laid emphasis on the importance of communal harmony and how Gandhi tried to address the communal question. Gandhi drew from many faiths in his philosophy and actions and his religious beliefs and his commitment to pluralism are best expressed in his own words:"I believe in the fundamental Truth of all great religions of the world. And I believe that if only we could, all of us, read the scriptures of the different faiths from the standpoint of the followers of those faiths, we should find that they were at the bottom all one and were all helpful to one another". Dr. Malik made reference to "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam" (The World is One Family) which is considered the most important moral value in the Indian society. The Holy Qur an also clearly stresses the importance of religious freedom. There is no compulsion in the matters of religion. Faith is an individual concern and commitment, between you and the One God. Religion should not be used for political purposes. Webinar proceedings The next speech was given by Mr. Altaf Hussain Wani, Head, Department of History. He spoke on "Gandhi and Satyagraha in South Africa". In his childhood, it is belied that Gandhi "restless like mercury". He was having less interest in school and physical activities. His only companion was the stories of Raja Harishchandra. Gandhi after finishing his college decided to study law in England. After finishing his studies in England he grabbed the opportunity to visit South Africa to fight the law suit of Dada Abdullah. In South Africa he tested his Satyagraha tactic for the first time and succeeded in achieving the things which were impossible otherwise. He carried these ideas with him to India in 1915 and utilized them on repeated occasions. Dr. Sajad Ahmad Padder spoke on "Gandhism & the Contemporary World". Excerpts: Gandhism today is alive and active in every part of the world. The name of Gandhi transcends the boundaries of race, religion and nation-states. Today, Gandhi is remembered for his passionate adherence to the practice of non-violence and his supreme humanism. For this very reason the UN General Assembly adopted a resolution on 15th June 2007 declaring 2 October, the birthday of Gandhi, as the "International Day of Non-Violence". The resolution reaffirms "the universal relevance of the principle of non-violence" and the desire "to secure a culture of peace and tolerance." If we dare to say that the twenty-first century is the century of the common man, then we see that Gandhism has even more relevance in this age, and Gandhi will inspire generations of individuals fighting for goodness of the society. We may borrow Gandhi's own words on Ahimsa, and say that Gandhism is only for the courageous people. That is why we have to understand the concept of non-violence in the right perspective. As Gandhi said in 1939: "For I cannot in any case tolerate cowardice; Let no one say when I am gone that I taught the people to be cowards...cowardice is worse than violence because cowards can never be non-violent." Gandhi-ji has been subjected to some criticism as well. During the recent "Black Lives Matter" demonstrations

over the death of George Floyd, a black man, in America, a lot of rage was expressed against racism and injustice faced by Black and ethnic minorities across the world. Many monuments and statues were defaced or destroyed including that of Gandhi in UK & USA. All one can say in defence of Gandhi is that he too had to grow ethically and, indeed, the rest of his life did manifest an unparalleled ethical development. Dr. Salma Khan threw some light on the "Back to Village" programme of the J&K Government. She highlighted the benefits of such programmes for the rural masses. Gandhi was a strong advocate of Gram Swaraj or Village self-rule and favored decentralization of power to local selfgovernments. All those policies and programmes which are meant for the welfare of villages are completely in sync with the Gandhian philosophy. Ms Ambreen Gul spoke on the theme: "The Gandhian Approach to Development: A model for Sustainable Development and Inclusive Growth". Gandhi realized that his vision was idealistic and considered it a goal towards which we can strive. It is easy to dismiss Gandhi's vision as utopian and impossible to achieve. However, the sentiment behind this vision and the concern for his fellow countrymen has to be respected. It must also be appreciated that he saw the problems with neoliberal capitalism and mindless consumerism for what they were a long time before these problems became apparent. In this backdrop, it becomes imperative to revisit Gandhi and try to understand and implement his economic and social philosophy to usher in an inclusive and more sustainable growth. Mr. Mukhtar Ahmad Mir spoke of the theme: "M.K Gandhi and Emancipation of Women". Excerpts: Gandhi was one of the pioneers of women empowerment in India. His philosophy is largely based on morality and religion. He was intensely conscious of the need for improving the status of women in Indian society. 



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

The next speech was given by Mr. Altaf Hussain Wani, Head, Department of History. He spoke on "Gandhi and Satyagraha in South Africa". In his childhood, it is belied that Gandhi 'restless like mercury'. He was having less interest in school and physical activities. His only companion was the stories of Raja Harishchandra. Gandhi after finishing his college decided to study law in England. After finishing his studies in England he grabbed the opportunity to visit South Africa to fight the law suit of Dada Abdullah. In South Africa he tested his Satyagraha tactic for the first time and succeeded in achieving the things which were impossible otherwise. He carried these ideas with him to India in 1915 and utilized them on repeated occasions.

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#### Excerpts:

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"For I cannot in any case tolerate cowardice; Let no one say when I am gone that I taught the people to be cowards...cowardice is worse than violence because cowards can never be non-violent."

Gandhi-ji has been subjected to some criticism as well. During the recent 'Black Lives Matter' demonstrations over the death of George Floyd, a black man, in America, a lot of rage was expressed against racism and injustice faced by Black and ethnic minorities across the world. Many monuments and statues were defaced or destroyed including that of Gandhi in UK & USA. #### Report on "the one day National webinar on Future of Nanostructures"



## 02 September 2020

The Department of Political Science, Govt. Degree College for Women, Anantmag, organised a national webinar on 02 September 2020 on the theme: Diplomatic Rapprochement between the UAE & Israel: Implications for the Palestinian Cause.

The department is very thankful to the hon'ble Principal, Dr. (Professor) Ali Mohd Dar, for encouraging us to pursue the academic activities online during this pandemic with an assured technical support from the department of Computer Sciences.

The webinar started with an introductory speech by Dr. Mohd. Amin Malik, HoD, Political Science, GDC Women, Anantnag. Dr. Malik gave the geo-political background of the crisis in middle-east and the emergence of Palestine issue.

The next speech was given by hon'ble Principal Dr. Ali Mohd Dar. He presented a historical overview about the Israel-Palestine Conflict which resulted in a huge loss of life & property.

The guest speaker, Prof. Asmer Beg, gave a comprehensive account of the emerging geopolitical scenario in middle-east and its ramifications on the Palestinian cause. The speaker highlighted that the diplomatic rapprochement between the United Arab Emirates & Israel, "Abraham Accord of 13th August 2020", facilitated by the Trump administration finds tacit support from Saudi Arabia and few other Arab nations. The agreement envisages recognition of Israel by UAE while the former agrees to suspend (not off the table) the plan of annexing parts of the West Bank. Prof. Beg was also critical of Turkey's hypocritical attitude vis-à-vis the Palestine issue. It had recognised Israel more than seven decades back but now frowns upon the UAE's diplomatic maneuvers. Prof. Beg regretted that the 'Two-State' solution is virtually dead with only the announcement of death pending.

On the one hand, there is consolidation of an alliance between the UAE, Saudi Arabia and the USA. But on the other side, the alliance between Turkey, Qatar & Iran is also shaping-up. The bloody conflicts in Iraq, Syria, Libya and Yemen have a lot to do with the rivalry between these two groups. It's believed that the recent developments would further push Palestinians to the margins and lead to more violence in the region.

The webinar was moderated by Dr. Sajad Padder and Prof. Mukhtar Ahmad presented the






