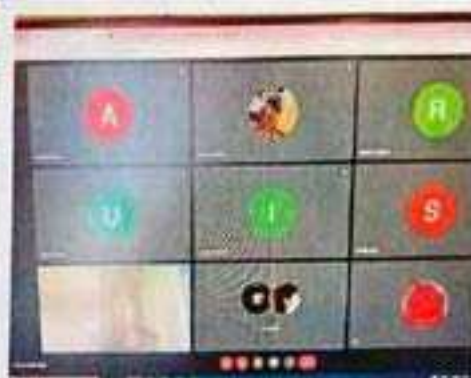
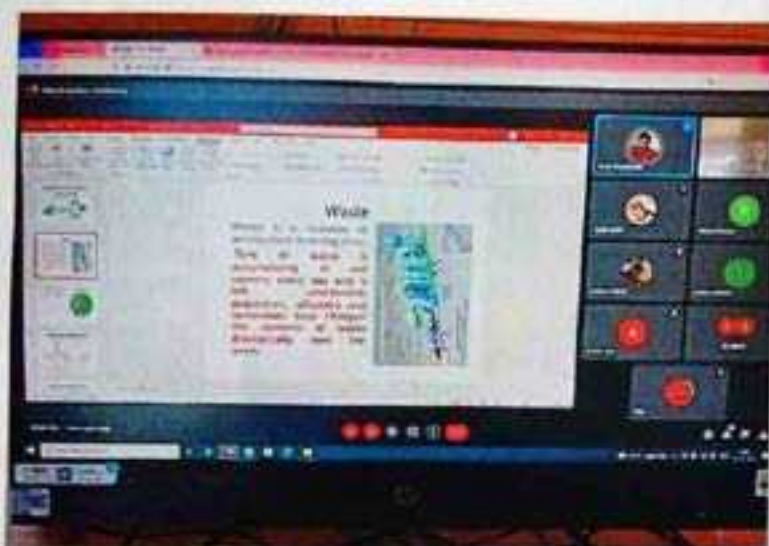

Report of Webinar on Theme "Waste Management Practices" on eve of Clean India Program on 16/10/2021



A Webinar on the theme "Waste Management Practices" on the eve of **Clean India Program** was organized today on 16-10-2021, by NSS Units of college in collaboration with Waste Management Committee of college under the able guidance and support of **Prof./Dr Irfan ul Majid, Principal GDC for Women Anantnag**. The respected speaker in the webinar was **Dr Khursheed Ahmad Wani, Lecturer on Academic Arrangement at GDC Bijbehara**. The webinar was attended by more than 70 participants which included the students, research scholars, faculty members etc of various educational institutions. The session started with the welcome address delivered by **Prof Rouoof Habib, Assistant Professor Environmental Sciences and NSS Program Officer I** and the whole session/event was moderated by him. The webinar evoked an inordinate response and proved to be very much informative for the participants. The speaker in his talk explained various categories of Wastes like Municipal Waste, Biomedical Waste, Industrial Waste, Construction and Demolition Waste etc and their sources. He discussed the impact of various types of Waste on the different components of environment like air, water, soil etc. The speaker was of the view that no material is waste but it is our perception, lack of knowledge/technology and its wrong place and time which makes it waste. The speaker stressed on segregation of waste at the source of its production into biodegradable and non biodegradable.

Brief report of visit of NSS Volunteers to Pai-Bugh (an adopted village under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan) regarding Waste Management awareness - on 30/10/2021

The NSS units of the college today on 30/10/2021 visited Pai-Bugh, village adopted by our college under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, for creating awareness regarding waste Management under "Clean India Program". Pai-Bugh is a village located at a distance of just 05 kms from our college. The NSS volunteers organized a door to door awareness campaign regarding Waste Management awareness and stressed upon the reduction in use of polythene. We also made the public aware regarding the composting technique of waste recycling. We then visited the Govt Primary School Pai-Bugh presently clubbed with the Govt Middle School Krangsoo where Convener waste Management Dr Imtiyaz Ahmad Tali delivered a lecture to staff as well as students regarding waste collection, segregation, recycling and proper disposal. The small kids of the school were found to be much more interested. The NSS volunteers then sung various rhymes along with students of the school regarding protection of environment. They also asked the students to make their parents at home aware about the harmful impacts of polythene use and recovery of material from waste by techniques like composting.

Brief report of visit of NSS Volunteers to Pahalgam regarding Waste Management awareness among the stakeholders on 12/10/2021

In response to **Order No. DC/HE/Audit/2021/659**, Dated: **01-10-2021** issued by Directorate of colleges, Higher Education Department regarding action plan for implementation of "**Clean India Program**" the NSS units in collaboration with Waste Management Committee of the college are in process of organizing a series of events. The first event of the series of events was the organizing of Cleanliness Drive in College Campus on 09/10/2021. Today on 12/10/2021 the 2nd event of the series was organized in which the NSS volunteers rendered their service at Pahalgam by creating awareness among various stakeholders like tourists, shopkeepers, Park management authority, local visitors, common public etc. The NSS officers gave a demonstration regarding the segregation of waste and stressed upon the waste producers and handlers to segregate the waste into biodegradable and non-biodegradable at the source and collect the same in separate dustbins. The NSS volunteers sensitized the stakeholders regarding the harmful effects of polythene and other single use plastic material on air (due to burning of waste), water (due to disposal of waste in Lidder river) and soil (due to its disposal or dispersal on soil). They also sensitized the locals about the defacement caused by the dispersed plastic and polythene material in parks, on banks of Lidder river and inside it. The shopkeepers were also made aware regarding the alternatives to polythene available in the market in order to minimize the production of polythene waste. The NSS volunteers were holding the play cards with various slogans related to management of waste and the visitors/tourists passing thereby were made aware by the volunteers about the campaign and the ways by which the scenic beauty of Pahalgam, which attracts the tourists from all over the world, can be maintained.

Brief report of visit of NSS Volunteers to Bumzoo regarding Waste Management awareness and Cleanliness Drive on Banks of Lidder River on 29/10/2021

In continuation to the series of activities under "Clean India Program" the NSS units of the college today on 29/10/2021 visited Bumzoo for creating awareness regarding Waste Management and Cleanliness Drive on banks of Lidder River. Lidder river being one of the famous lotic water body of Anantnag adds to the scenic beauty of not only Pahalgam but the whole stretch from Pahalgam to Khanabal, where it merges with Jehlum. Along the banks of Lidder river many villages are inhabited and due to the lack of awareness and selfish attitude of inhabitants, large quantities of waste is being dumped into the water body, which in turn pollutes the water by increasing the BOD of water and thus rendering it unfit for commercial use and deteriorating its aesthetic and recreational value. The NSS volunteers took dustbins from the college and cleaned the banks of the river at the site. The spot was chosen due to large disposal of waste into the water body by the local community. The Volunteers not only cleaned the banks but also made the community aware about the harmful effects of waste disposal into the river as it leads to health effects downstream and leads to defacement of river Lidder.

Report of Webinar on theme, "Stop Child Sexual Abuse and POCSO(Protection of Children from Sexual Offences) Act 2012" organized on 31-08-2021



A Webinar on the theme, " Stop Child Sexual Abuse and POCSO Act 2012" was organized by NSS units of the College in Collaboration with **SAKSHI-An NGO**. Sakshi is an organization working to empower youth, women, children and marginalized groups by focusing on life skills, equality and gender mainstreaming through trainings, research and communication. Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Directorate of National Service Scheme has authorized Sakshi to conduct awareness sessions on rights and responsibilities for Gender Equality and Orientation and Capacity Building for compliance of POCSO Act, 2012. The main objective of the Webinar was to make NSS volunteers POCSOA Champions or Rakshans. The respectable speaker during the Webinar was Ms Aditi Kishore. The speaker highlighted the various reasons responsible for child sexual abuse in which she stressed on lack of parental care as the main cause. She then talked about the ways by which children are being sexually abused and the possible solutions for them. She also informed the participants about the POCSO(Protection of Children from Sexual Offences) Act 2012 and various sections of the act dealing with definition, rules for reporting the sexual offence, punishment etc. The speaker made the participants aware about the "Bad Touch" and "Safe Touch" through various videos. She also highlighted that the sexual offences are not being reported due to the social stigma associated with them and it is the duty of parents to report such issues so that the child sexual abuse can be stopped in future.

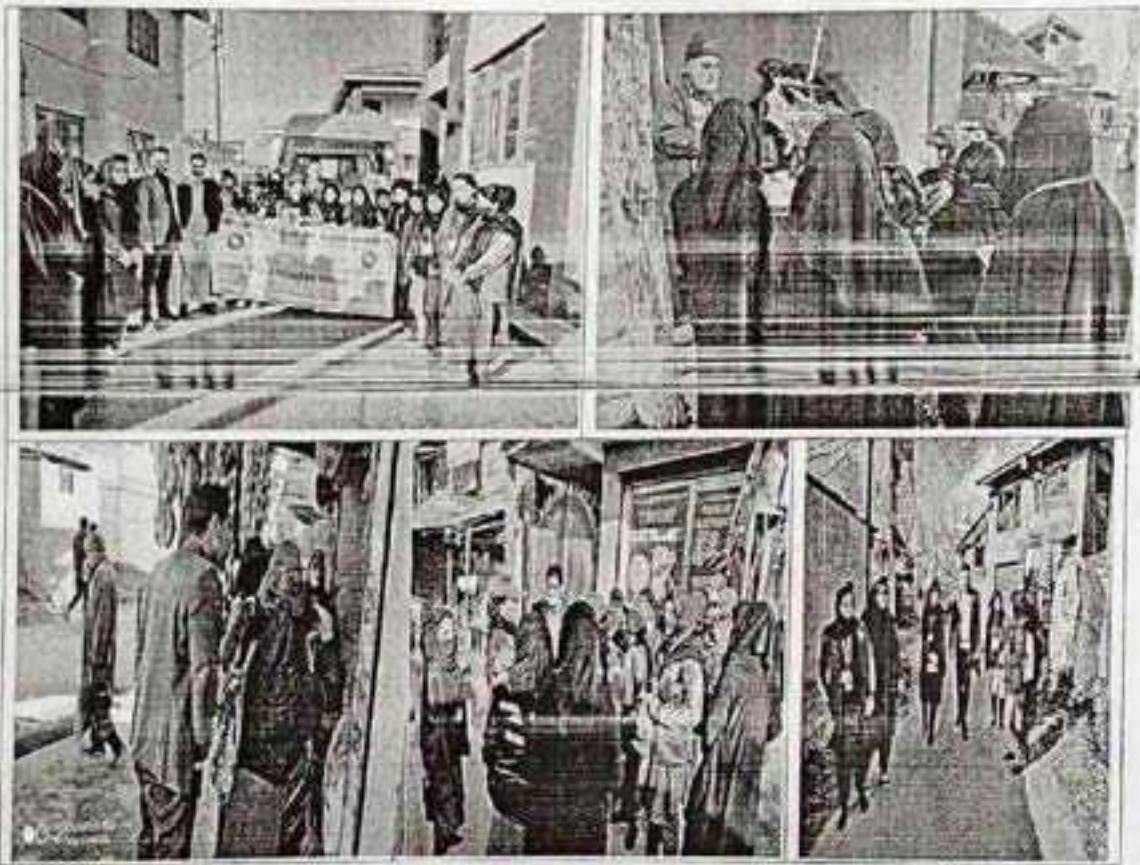



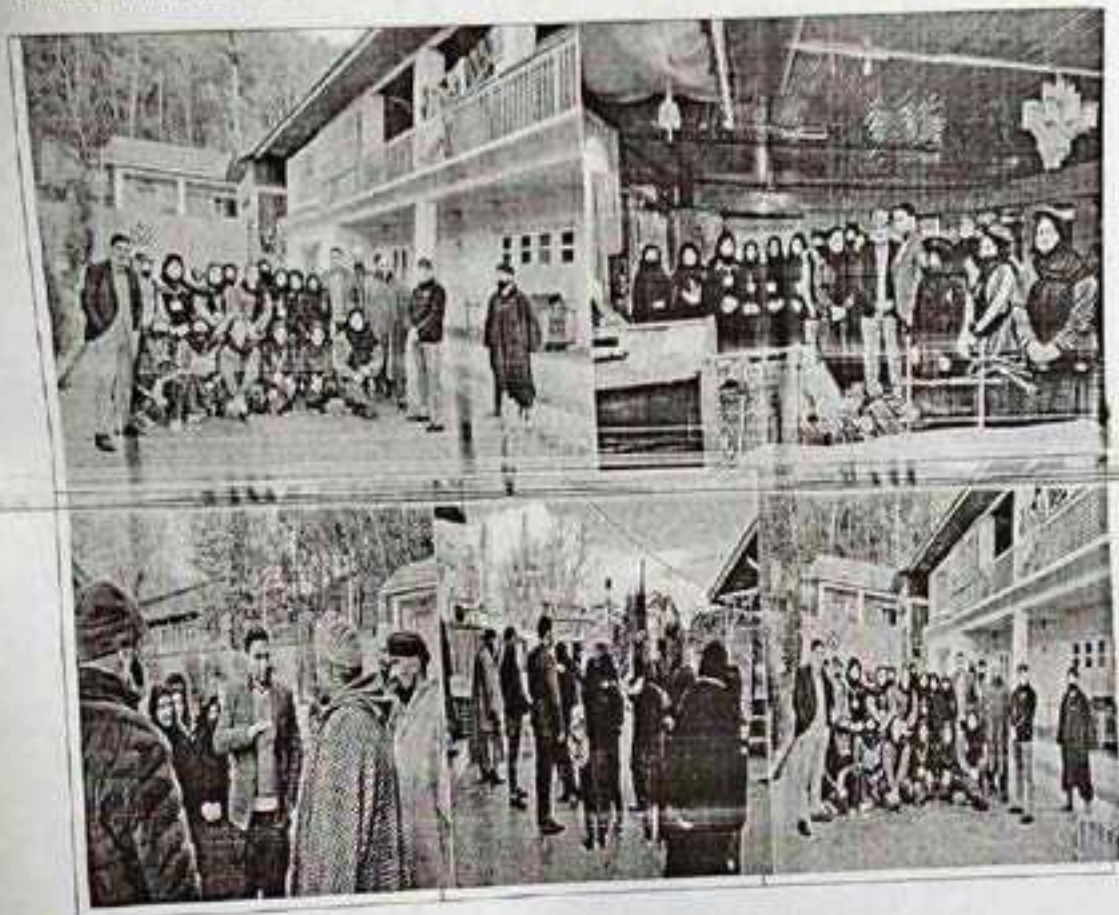

Report of Visit to Govt Middle School Chee on eve of Celebration of
"Swastha Balak-Balika Spardha" or "POSHAN ABHIYAN" on

The NSS Program officers along with NSS Volunteers of College today visited Govt Middle School Chee-an adopted Village in connection with celebration of "POSHAN ABHIYAN". The visit was flagged off by the Worthy Principal of our College, Dr Irfan-ul-Majid. POSHAN Abhiyaan or Scheme for Holistic Nutrition or National Nutrition Mission, is Government of India's flagship programme to improve nutritional outcomes for children(0-6yrs), pregnant women and lactating mothers. Poshan Abhiyan, also known as the National Nutrition Mission (NNM), was launched in 2018 by the Government of India with the aim of tackling the malnutrition problem prevalent in India.

The Program Officers analyzed the nutritional health status of children of Nursery, KG Classes and Class Ist primary by weighing them and comparing the same with their heights and it was found that most of the children were found to be underweight or undernourished. The NSS program officer Mr Imtiyaz Ahmad Hajam then delivered a speech on the POSHAN Abhiyan Scheme, which was attended by the staff of the school in addition to the students. Mr Rouoof Habib, NSS Program Officer then delivered a speech on the harmful effects of Junk Foods in which he highlighted various effects of eating junk food like obesity, learning and memory problems, loss of appetite and digestion, mental impact leading to depression and inadequate growth and development. The speaker stressed upon the students for not making use of these foods and instead taking fruits. An interactive session was organised for the students in which Dr Salma Khan Assistant Professor in the Department of political science focussed on the salient features of our constitution like Written Constitution, Parliamentary system, Fundamental rights, Fundamental duties, Amendment process of the constitution, ideology of Secularism, Socialism and Democracy, Language policy.

A WRITTEN CONSTITUTION

The Constitution of India is a written constitution. It was framed by a Constituent Assembly which was established for the purpose in 1946.

There are two types of constitutions in the world. Most of them are written. The first modern written constitution was the American constitution. The British constitution is unwritten, consists of customs and conventions which have grown over the years.

The framers of our constitution tried to put everything in black and white.

UNIVERSAL ADULT FRANCHISE

Article 326 of the Constitution of India provides universal adult suffrage. The voting age has now come down from 21 to 18. Anybody who has completed 18 years of age, irrespective of his caste, creed, sex or religion, is eligible to vote in general elections.

This is one of the most revolutionary aspects of Indian democracy.
