After discussion Dr. Touseef Ahmad thanked the resource person and the final vote of thanks was presented by Dr. Manzoor Ahmad.

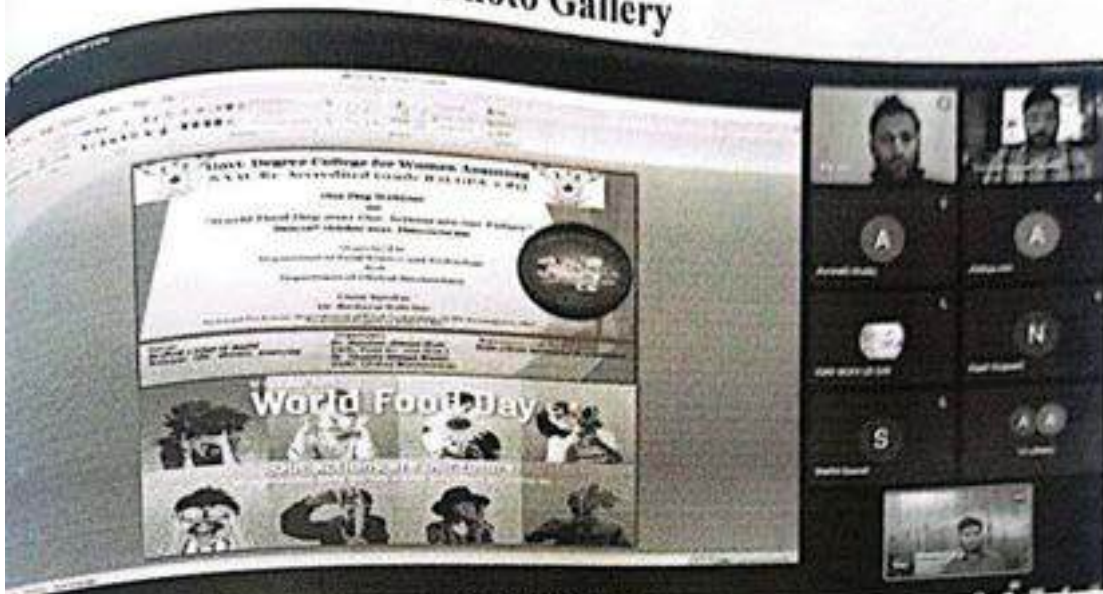

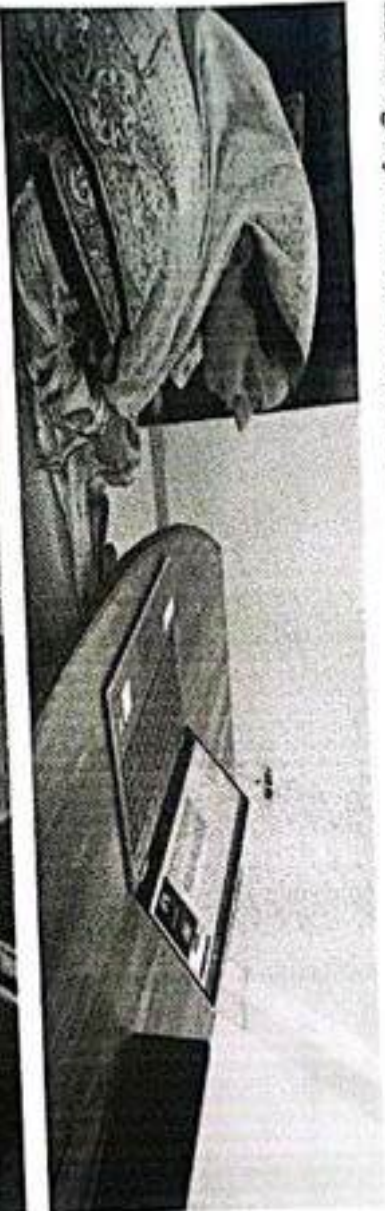

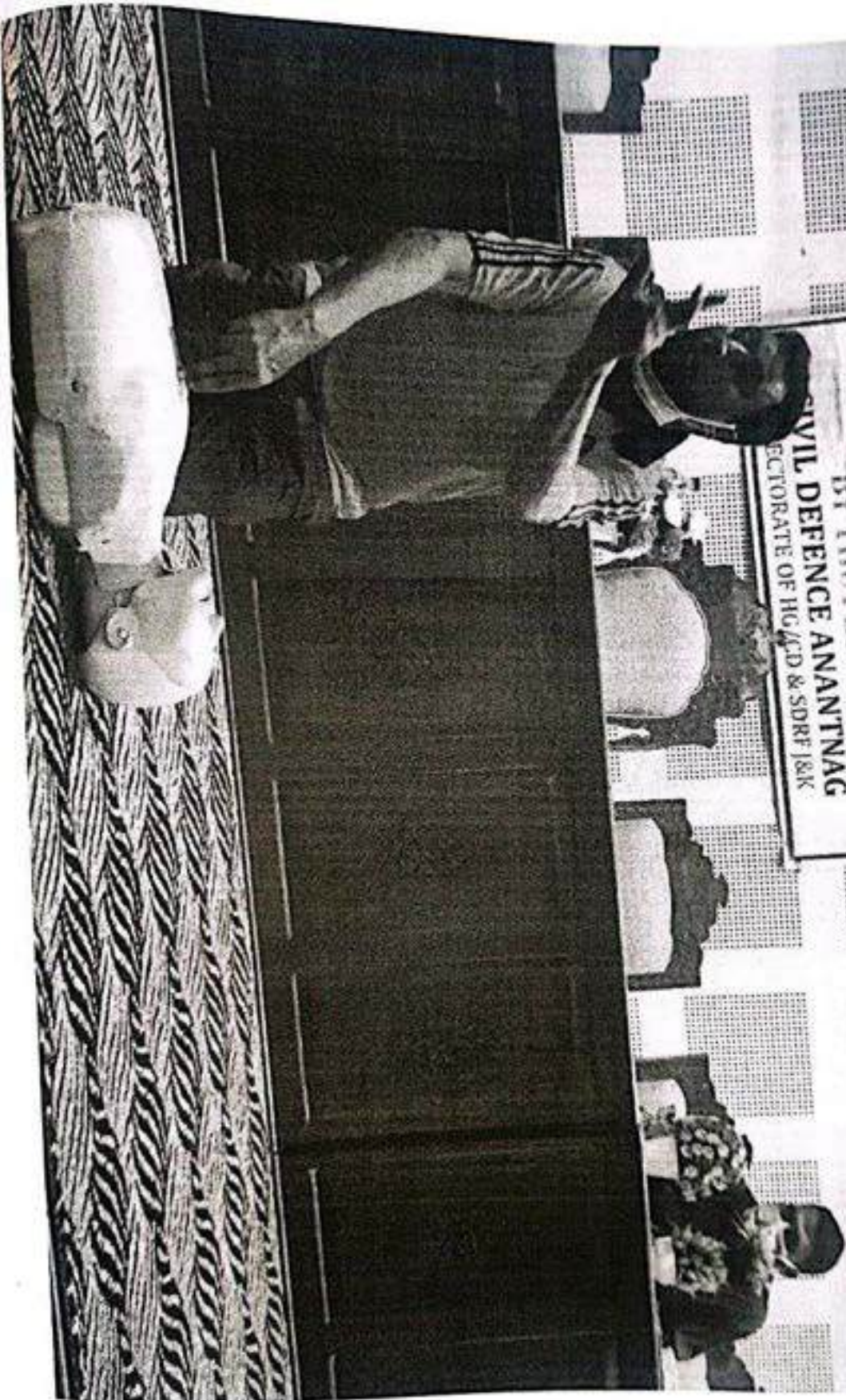
### **Report on awareness cum guidance session under the theme "First Aid, Fire Fighting and Flood Rescue"**

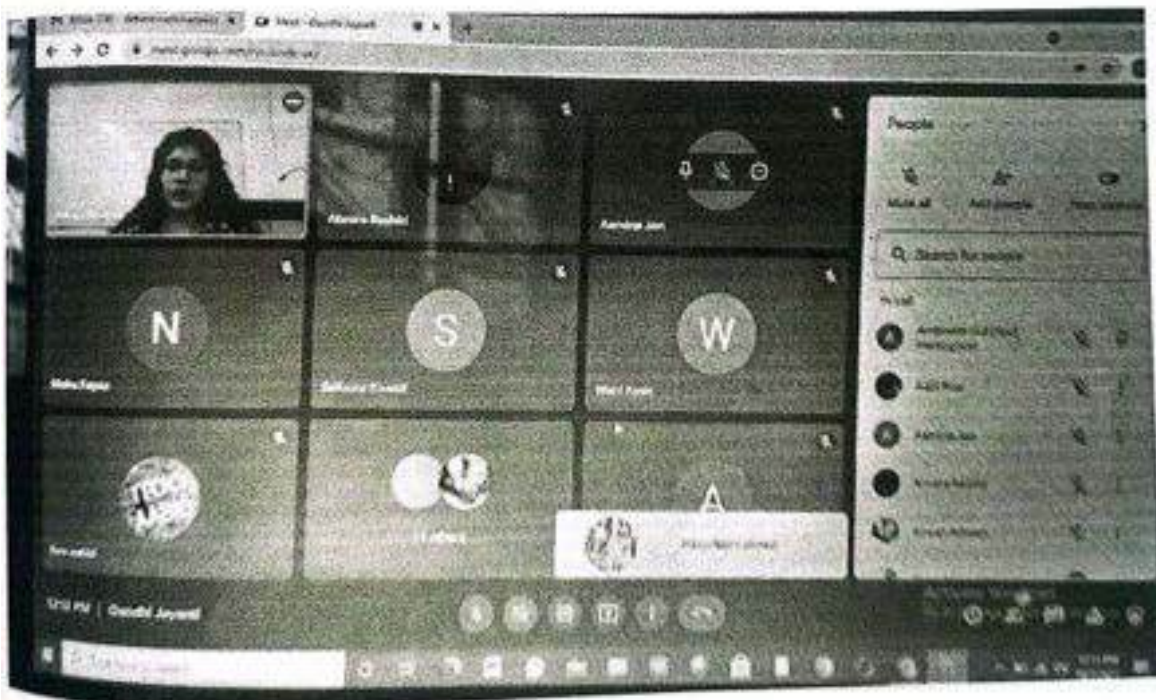

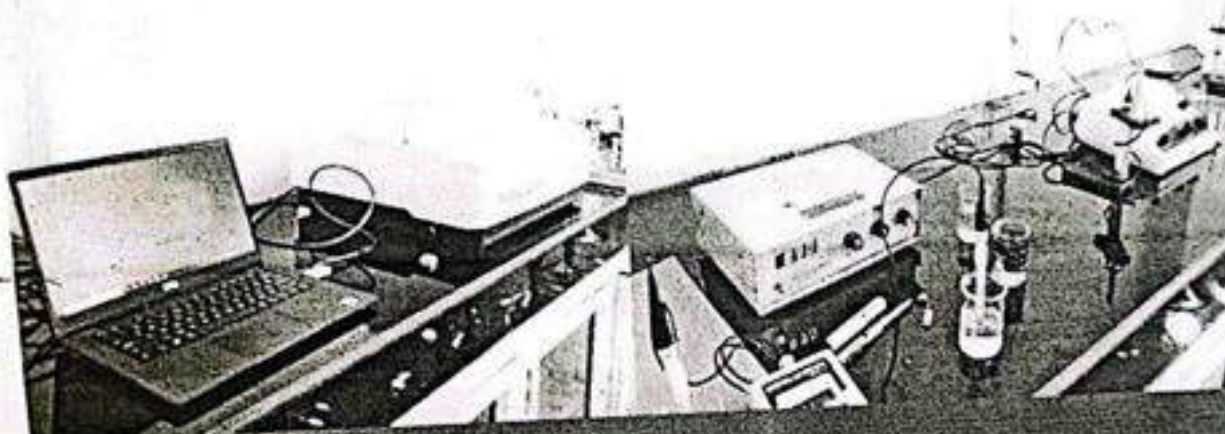

#### Report on one day webinar on "Career Opportunities in Physics" on 21<sup>st</sup> December 2021.

A one day webinar on "Career opportunities in Physics" was organized by the Department of Physics, Govt. Degree College for women, Anantnag on 21 December 2021 in Conference Hall at 12:00 noon.



Dr. Suraya Bashir started the program with an inaugural speech and brief introduction about physics. The program was presided by Dr Irfan ul Majid Principal Govt Degree College for Women Anantnag who gave a brief talk about the webinar. The program was followed by the Guest lecture by Dr. Seemin Rubab Professor, Department of Physics, National Institute of Technology Srinagar. She has delivered about seventy expert talks at INSIRE Science campus, State Institute of Education for Capacity Building program of +2 lecturers, UGC-HRDC of university of Kashmir, Patna University, Bihar University and MANNU. She has delivered extension lectures at various schools and colleges.

She talked about different pipelines that a student can take after doing BSc in Physics. The introduction of Project work/ Dissertation at BSc level can enhance the scoring as well as the research skills of the students. The concept of Virtual Lab was also introduced by the speaker that runs under NPTEL. The National Initiative on Undergraduate Science (NIUS), a major initiative of HBCSE (TIFR) concerning tertiary science education in India, was launched in the summer of 2004. The current structure of the NIUS programme for students consists of an exposure cum enrichment camp followed by two to three camps for completion of project work. The main aim of the exposure cum enrichment camps is to excite undergraduate students about basic sciences. NIUS camps include sessions related to -a) frontier research areas in the discipline, b) core areas/concepts, c) laboratory activities involving planning and decision making, d) comprehension of scientific papers, and e) problems solving. At the end of the exposure camps, a certain number of students,

depending on the availability of mentors, are selected for NIUS projects that continue for about three successive semesters or so.

She talked about JAM test which is organized by IISc Bangalore. JAM 2022 will have seven Test Papers, namely, (i) Biotechnology (BT), (ii) Chemistry (CY), (iii) Economics (EN), (iv) Geology (GG), (v) Mathematics (MA), (vi) Mathematical Sciences (MS) and (vii) Physics (PH). Economics (EN) paper is added since 2021. Indian Institute of Astrophysics has launched an integrated M.Sc.-Ph.D Programme in Physics and Astrophysics in collaboration with Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU), New Delhi. The programme will admit bright, highly motivated students with Bachelor's degree in Science/Engineering, selected on an all-India basis. TIFR and IIRI also conducted integrated M.Sc.-Ph.D. program in Physics.



This session was followed by the demonstration and hands-on-training session to all students of the Physics. The participants showed keen interest in webinar and have gained a hand-on experience. Overall, students participated from physics departments of the institution and from other institutions as well. This workshop was found to be a good learning experience for the teaching staff and students of the institution. The webinar was concluded with vote of thanks by Dr. Hamid Nanda.
